

Who We Are



Laker Tech is a state-of-the-art technology hub located within GVSU Laker Store. It was created as a retail space to provide the technology and resources needed by the Grand Valley community. At Laker Tech you will find a large selection of Apple and Dell computers, Apple and Microsoft tablets, and gaming and tech accessories.

Working with GVSU IT's Technology Supply Office, Laker Tech has also established a selection of tech accessories that can be purchased in-store or online by campus departments using their purchasing cards.

What We Offer

Device Purchasing Guidance

Laker Tech provides guidance for students when purchasing computers, tablets, and wearables. Team members will work with students to determine the best device and configuration for their specific needs to help ensure their success throughout their university careers. Laker Tech also supports faculty and staff with personal device purchases, including the sales and promotions geared specifically towards them. Forty GVSU employees participated in the December 2021 Faculty & Staff Sale, many of whom used payroll deduction for payment.

Device Protection

Laker Tech offers Safeware device and AppleCare+ device protection for devices purchased from Laker Tech and other sources. Safeware is a comprehensive protection plan that covers power surges, mechanical and electrical failure, liquid spills and submersion, accidental damage, and failure from normal use. Safeware covers 100% of parts and labor, offers convenient service options, and does not require service fees. AppleCare+ coverage is based on the type of product for which it is purchased. AppleCare+ features include global repair coverage, 24/7 priority access to Apple experts, software support, and up to two incidents of accidental damage every 12 months (subject to service fee).

Freshman & Supporter Orientation Discounts

We have welcomed students and supporters back to campus for in-person Orientation for the first time in three years by offering discounts on accessories and device protection when guests purchase a qualifying device.




GVSU SAVE




Partnering in Affordability

Providing affordable course materials has always been a priority for GVSU Laker Store. For years, we had one of the strongest used book programs in the midwest. That evolved into working with publishers to substantially reduce the cost of new books - sometimes 50% less than other stores or from online vendors. Over the last few years, the focus nationally has been on digital materials. In 2019-2020, GVSU partnered with a few faculty and publishers to pilot GVSU SAVE, our digital course materials program. This past year, we opened up the program to all academic departments that wished to participate.

GVSU SAVE requires constant communication and collaboration across units and with vendor partners to deliver this quality content to students at the most affordable prices.


