•Copper: You will each need to purchase a sheet of copper: \$38
Printmaking Proofing Paper:
8 or more sheets
•Japanese-Type of Paper:
Kitikata, Hosho, Kozo, etc.: <u>2 or more sheets</u>
•A Sketchbook/Notebook
•One Etching/Litho Needle: #05 or #06-A round needle with a pointed tip-not square
•3-4 brushes, suitable for oil painting: flat or round, or both
•One sheets of clear acetate or mylar, .005" thick: (18 x 24"or larger)
•Sharpie marker: One or more, fine to medium tipped
•Regular pencils-HB, B or softer: One or more
•1" Blue painters tape: One role
•12" metal ruler
•An Old Shirt or apron
•Work gloves or rubber gloves
•5 X-acto blades and a blade holder
