MATERIALS LIST

Most supplies can be purchased at the <u>Laker Store</u> on campus, or at an online art supplier like <u>BLICK Art Materials</u>, <u>Utrecht</u>, or <u>Jerry's Artarama</u>. Also, feel free to access GR stores like Service Reproduction, Michael's or Hobby Lobby in a pinch.

- Hardware: A computer (MAC or PC). It must be able to run the Adobe Suite or similar software
- A mouse for your computer. A mouse is important when using Illustrator! It makes using the tools in Illustrator *so much* easier.
- Software: The <u>Adobe Suite</u> (Illustrator) for the semester. This is free and info should be sent directly to you from Adobe prior to the beginning of this course
- Flash drive for extra storage
- * Notebook (9 x 12" sketchbook or similar already in use is OK as long as blank sheets are available)
- * H pencil or lighter (for marking placement of work before gluing)
- * T-square or metal ruler
- * Rubber cement or glue stick
- * X-acto knife & Blades
- * Self-healing cutting board, at least 12 x 18"
- * Storage container for materials (Art Bin) or of your choosing
- 7 pieces of white illustration board 15 x 20"
- A variety of synthetic brushes in small-medium sizes (square and angled are important)
- Palette knife
- Roll of Scotch Brand <u>removable</u> magic tape (3M time #811)

Note: be sure to purchase the *removable* version of this tape. Regular magic tape will not work.

Purchase 2 oz tubes of each of these colors in either Liquitex or Golden Heavy Body

- Roll of paper towels
- Plastic palette
