•Supplies can be purchased from the <u>GVSU Laker Store</u>, <u>Dick Blick Art</u> <u>Supplies</u>, <u>Utrecht Art Supplies</u> and <u>Amazon.com</u>

Paper

- •White or off-white printmaking paper: 6 or more sheets: \$3-\$5 a sheet.
- •Japanese-Type of Paper: Kitikata, Hosho, Kozo, etc.: One or more sheets
- •Sketchbook/Notebook: 8"x10" average size

Tools

- •One Etching/Drypoint Needle: #05 or #06: A round needle with a pointed tip-not square
- •Sharpie marker: One or more, fine to medium tipped
- •Pencils: HB to B
- A pencil sharpener
- •1" blue painter's tape: One role
- •5 X-acto blades and a blade holder
- •Work gloves or rubber gloves
- •3-4 brushes, suitable for oil painting: flat or round, or both

Other Supplies

•Copper

You will each need to purchase a sheet of copper (Minimum 12 x 18") to complete required work. Copper is supplied in 18"x24" and 18"x12" sheets. You can purchase copper by using the QR code posted in the GVSU Printshop classroom.

*A copy of your receipt showing that you purchased the copper must be printed and given to the instructor.

- •A sheet of Clear Acetate or Mylar: 18"x24" on average
- An Old Shirt or Apron
- •Old fabric you don't mind getting ink on.
- •A clear 12"x12" plexiglass sheet panel with 0.04" thickness
