## **Tools & Supplies**

•Copper: You will each need to purchase a sheet of copper.

Copper is supplied in 18"x24" and 18"x12" sheets. You can purchase copper by using the QR code posted in the GVSU Printshop classroom. A copy of your receipt showing that you purchased the copper must be printed and given to the instructor.

- •Printmaking Proofing Paper: Such as Stonehenge or Lennox 22"x30" sheets 8 or more sheets
- Japanese-Type of Paper:

Kitikata, Hosho, Kozo, etc.: 2 or more sheets

- •A Sketchbook/Notebook
- •One Etching/Litho Needle: #05 or #06-A round needle with a pointed tip-not square
- •3-4 brushes, suitable for oil painting: flat or round, or both
- •One sheets of clear acetate or mylar, .005" thick: (18 x 24" or larger)
- •Sharpie Marker: One or more, fine to medium tipped
- •Regular pencils-HB, B or softer: One or more
- •1" Blue Painters Tape: One role
- •12" metal ruler
- •An Old Shirt or apron
- Work gloves or rubber gloves
- •5 X-acto blades and a blade holder
